Australia Post's \$2 billion investment program to create a world-class parcels and logistics network is the single largest investment in the national network in our 200 year history.

Expansions and upgrades to a number of Australia Post sites across the country have made them more efficient, reliable, safer and more environmentally-friendly.

The expansion and upgrade of Melbourne Parcel Facility at Sunshine West has doubled parcel processing capacity, provided significant safety improvements and environmental benefits. Work on the Melbourne Parcel Facility commenced in July 2013.

- The extended facility is 30,000 square metres, one and a half times the playing surface at the MCG.
- Parcel processing capacity has more than doubled from 9,000 parcels per hour to more than 23,000 parcels per hour in time for Christmas period. In 2015, 25,800 parcels per hour will be processed.
- Overall capacity has increased from 220,000 items per day to 568,000.
- Six-sided scanners and electronic scales capture each parcel's smart barcode, weight and dimensions, so that we can better track parcels through our network.
- Real-time monitoring immediately identifies any potential issues that may impact customer service.
