At Roy Hill, a sustainable Supply System is the foundation of its Supply Chain discipline. Utilising similar concepts to those adopted in the FMCG and manufacturing industries, the goal of the Roy Hill supply system is to optimise production availability, in line with demand chain requirements.

The Supply System consists of the business functions of Maintenance, Engineering Services, Supply Chain, Procurement and Accounts Payable; all co-located within the Supply System building. This is a first in mining, where Roy Hill owns and controls the distribution center and all the functions within.
