The presenter David Mulhall, was born in Brisbane and completed school at Marist College Ashgrove. He graduated from the Officer Cadet School Portsea in 1984 into the Royal Australian Corps of Transport. After gaining regimental, staff and representational experience, including a posting to the British Army’s School of Logistics to study advanced operational logistics, Major General Mulhall was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel in January 2000.



Major General Mulhall was promoted to Colonel in July 2005 and served as the Director Personnel Operations – Army, before deploying as the Chief of Plans (Logistics), Multi-National Force – Iraq. A posting as the Director Logistics – Army followed, and then attendance at the Centre for Defence and Strategic Studies in 2008. Major General Mulhall was promoted to Brigadier and appointed as the inaugural Chief of Staff Army Headquarters in January 2009. He then had the great privilege to command 17th Combat Service Support Brigade from 2011 to 2013.
